

# **GOLDEN ARROW BOWHUNTERS INDOOR LEAGUE RULES**

## **GENERAL**

- All participants will compete against each other, there is no classifications based on equipment, however cadets will be separate from the adults
- A combination of 30 Rinehart and Mackenzie ASA style 12 ring targets will be shot using one arrow per target
- The range will consist of 10 lanes with three targets per lane
- Cadets 14 and under will have one target per lane and shoot two arrows per target
- All lanes will be marked and you must shoot at targets dually marked with the corresponding marking only
- You earn points by hitting the target with your arrow at the rate of 12 points per 12 ring hit, 10 points per 10 ring, eight points for the eight ring, five points for anything in the body, head, leg or any part not denoted by a scoring ring and zero points for a miss, only one score per target, highest score prevails
- All scores should be denoted on the scorecard provided
- Shooting can take place anytime Wednesday and by Thursday night at 9:00 pm.  
**ALL SCORES MUST BE IN BY NINE PM THURSDAY**
- Three scores by the conclusion of the third week are required to be eligible for the individual and team competitions
- You have until January 18, 2007 9:00pm to post three scores
- You are allowed two absences after the third week to remain eligible for the team and individual competitions
- Absent scores will be posted as your average minus ten points
- You will not be allowed to make up any weeks missed after the third week
- You may shoot ahead only one week to avoid an absent score
- The league will be twelve consecutive weeks in duration

## **INDIVIDUAL COMPETITION**

- A 90% handicap will be used
- Handicaps are calculated using three of your most recent scores
- Handicaps will be figured to one tenth of a point
- Absent scores will not be factored in handicaps
- You will earn points each week based on your net score and how it ranks with everyone else in the league with the highest ranked score receiving the most points and the lowest score earning one point
- Ties will split the points earned on any given week
- A total of twelve weeks will be shot
- The top five point earners will receive prizes, the tiebreaker being higher average, then an even split if the averages are identical
- In order to keep the same amount of points every week, shooters that have dropped out of the league will still earn points using their absent score plus their most recent handicap

## TEAM COMPETITION

- Two person teams will be selected at the completion of the third week
- Teams will be chosen by average with the highest average paired with the lowest, second highest with the second lowest and so on
- Tiebreaker for identical averages will be ranking on individual competition, then highest weekly score if still tied
- Team competition will be head to head combined weekly score, with no handicap
- Teams will be placed in divisions so each team within a division will face each other at least once
- A weekly schedule will be posted so you know who you will be facing
- Your individual score will also be your team score, you do not shoot twice
- Team competition will last ten weeks, followed by a playoff in weeks 11 and 12
- Four teams will make the playoffs
- Since it is difficult to predict how many shooters will be involved, it is impossible to say how many divisions will be used, therefore a better explanation of qualifying for the playoffs, along with tiebreakers, will come at the completion of week three
- Those four teams will receive prizes
- In an effort to maintain fairness all participants whose team makes the playoffs, must have two people in the league score for them the final two weeks and sign the scorecard when finished. If you cannot find two people to score for you then one of the members running the league will do it-see Ron Kosinski, Dick Jerstad, John Fisher, John Kartes or Mike Miller

All scores will be posted here and on our website [www.goldenarrowbowhunters.com](http://www.goldenarrowbowhunters.com) after the third week and every week thereafter usually by the Friday following the completion of the week.

## PLAYOFF EXPLANATION

Playoffs will consist of the three division winners, tiebreaker within the division for first place will first be head to head then high average. A fourth playoff spot (wild card) will be given to the non-division winner with the best record with high average being the tie breaker. The best record division winner with the highest average will face the wild card team in week 11 and the second and third best division winner record will play in week 11. The winners of each match will face in the championship during week 12 for first place and the losers will play for third and fourth.
